Bible Camping Inc., our not-for-profit corporation, has two divisions: Red Cliff Bible Camp and Summit Trails Unlimited. Early on, STU would host trips as the Red Cliff camp site was being developed and then began offering trips each year in August. I have personally enjoyed around 20 of these trips with campers. This year in August, I led a 5-day trip to Brewster Lake in the Gros Ventre Mts. while Lorie led a 3-day trip in the mountains around Camp. My trip was extra special for my group as God allowed us to see many mountain peaks as well as wildlife deer, a big horn sheep, and 9 elk fifty yards or so from our campsite on the final day!

The summer of 2021 brought us many laborers. Missionary builder, Gary Hunt, was with us through the months of June, July, August. We also hosted a work group in July from Woodcrest Baptist Church in Fridley, MN. In August a family came from MI for two weeks to lay concrete block. Also in August a group of 18 came with Independent Baptist Builders International who built roofs, decks, and sheetrock firewalls in the Lodge and framed bathrooms in Big Sheep cabin. The following week a tile crew tiled the mechanical room in the Lodge. How I thank God for sending laborers! Please pray for safety, workers, and provision.



Dear Friends and Supporters,

What a whirlwind of a summer it has been! Our family moved up to camp May 31, and we spent one week cleaning the campground and starting the process of decorating for the summer theme of Jungle Adventure. That particular theme had been planned for the summer of 2020 before Covid restrictions caused us to cancel last

year's camps, so it was fun to see it come together for this summer! Our summer staff arrived on June 7th, but even before the summer started, we had been praying that this summer, God would show us "great and mighty things," taken from Jeremiah 33:3. During the first 2 weeks of staff training, He began to answer that prayer. We had 2 summer staff members and 2 staff kids accept Christ and/or get assurance of their salvation! During summer camp, we also had some volunteers come to continue work on the Lodge, although with full cabins most weeks, we were limited in how many volunteers we could house at camp. In short, we did see God do great and mighty things this summer, not only among the campers who came, but in the lives of our summer staff and families and in our own hearts, as well.

As we transition into the next season of service at Red Cliff, we ask for you to pray with us for the following areas.

Ladies' Retreat is coming up quickly! Please pray that plans will continue to come together and all the details will fall into place. Pray that it would be a time of refreshing for all who attend.
