Greetings from Snowy Wyoming,

Thank you for your prayers and support. As we looked back at the summer ministry, we cannot help but praise the Lord for the 6 salvations and the many decisions and many lives that were encouraged in the Gospel. We had many helpers and a bless summer staff. Praise God! Summit Trails, Science Camp, a pastor and wives retreat, and ladies retreat all went well, praise the Lord. **God gave safety and many lives were encouraged in God’s Word.** We are still getting notes from campers who were encouraged and refreshed during these camps. All this while a couple worked on the rock siding on the lodge and another set of volunteers worked on the railing on the back of the lodge and the spiral staircase railing (getting it ready for 2 volunteers who had been working on the stairs itself). Praise all be to God! We had a work crew that came who helped finish the siding on the lodge. They even rented a lift. This crew was a big answer to prayer. Praise God for His provision of help. We also had 2 men from Idaho who came to harvest firewood (cut dead standing trees) for camp and staff housing. David skidded them to the processing area. Praise God for safety and that there is enough for a good start next year.

David was also able to go recruiting to BJU with Mr. Dean and Lorie. It was a new experience; he enjoyed visiting with many he knows there and seeing his mom for 2 days when they landed in Charlotte. We are praying for a godly summer staff for 2025!

This fall we continue to pray for help and provision. Here are 2 instances that God used to remind us that His provision is just right. We were praying for funds to give out flowers with Bible tracts. God supplied heavy cream, so Wixi made homemade caramels and used those to give out the Gospel to around 50 people. We always pray that God will use them to save lost and encourage hearts. God’s other provision was that David needed help doing the splitting of firewood. Then one day we decided to just do it as a family. We paused school and went up to camp. David has been working at camp and splitting wood by himself. All 5 of us worked together and helped him deliver and stack for the MacGills and our family. Then Leonard and David brought one trailer to the Loftus and stacked it, plus parked one, while Leonard also helped him at camp to put the tent frame away and chuckwagon before the snow. We also had a friend from church who took time to go another day with David. God supplied just the right help before the snow. God is so very faithful.

As Wixi and the kids continue to do homeschool and reach others in our community, we see God’s care over and over. We also see conversations that God uses to help us share the Gospel with others. Continue to pray for the boy who comes to church each Sunday with our family. We are praying for his and his family’s Salvation. **Please pray for the Gospel tracts that will go out tomorrow.** Halloween is not a holiday we celebrate, yet the last 10 years we have had the opportunity to give out around 100 Bible tracts just by opening our home. We pray that as we give out candies with Bible tracts, God will use them to reach the lost.

We are so thankful for all God has done this fall. Please continue to pray for our health. Anah Grace is part of the marching band at the high school (Even with all her limitations, God allows her to do this.) She actually marched for the first time. God gave protection and her team actually got a 2, which is excellent. It was a blessing to visit the church in Casper and visit with many friends and meet camper’s parents. Yesterday, Anah Grace had a bad migraine, passed out, and fell, so she had a concussion, and we ended up at the clinic. We praise God it happened here in town. Please pray that even through the struggles of life, we can continue to share with our community how Great is God who cares even for our big and little struggles in our lives.

We hope this letter doesn’t just show how busy our ministry is here, but how Great is Our God who continues to do exceedingly abundantly above what we ask or think.
